**OIDHREACT AN CHLÁIR:** On Wednesday, August 22, 8pm-10.30pm in The

Malbay, as part of Heritage Week, a new intergenerational project, Community

Memories as a community cohesion resource for young and old, funded by the

Heritage Council, will be launched by retired High Court Judge, Bryan McMahon.

The project will involve videorecording the historical memories of 12 of the older

residents of the Miltown Malbay area as to community life and change between

1930 and 1980, from their diverse occupational perspectives. The interviews,

conducted by a mix of young and older local residents, will later be shown publicly,

with a view to promoting generational interaction and understanding, and will form

a Community Memory Bank archival asset for future generations.

The event will also feature the showing of a fascinating interview of Canon Séamus

Mullin, in which he recounts his memories of Kilrush and Scatterry Island in his

youth, his life as a priest, including as President of St Flannan's College, Ennis, and

his encounters with significant historical figures. This interview was the first of a

similar series conducted by Oidhreach an Chláir in 2017 with funding from the IPB

(Irish Public Bodies) Community Engagement Fund. A schedule for the showing

of the other 11 interviews in that IPB project over the Autumn at The Malbay will

be announced on the night. Admission to the event is free. Fáilte roimh chách.
