I wanted to tell him about Eucharist, but the look in his eyes, the despair in his face, the hopelessness of somebody else's life in his cart told me to forget it.

So, I smiled, and said "Hi.".... and gave him Eucharist.

A woman lived alone. Her husband dead, her family gone. And she talked at you, not to you; words, endless words spewed out. So, I listened, and gave her Eucharist.
