OIDHREACHT AN CHLÁIR presents, as part of its IPB-funded Community Memories Project series, a video interview of the well-known singer PJ Murríhy of Shandrum, Mullagh on Monday, November 12 at 8.30pm in The Malbay. Interviewed by his daughter Moira, PJ shares vivid memories of farming life, days in the bog, saving hay, trapping hares on Mutton Island, and of hurling (as well as football) in Mullagh. He shows a reaping hook bought in 1778 in Kiltrush, talks of piper Johnny Doran's visits and his impact locally, and of his own time with the Kilfenora Céilí Band and the Bannermen. PJ also tells the remarkable story of his neighbour Jane Hogan, reported lost in the torpedoing of the Lusitania in 1915 but who survived and walked home to Mullagh from Ennis. **QUIZ NIGHT:** A Quiz with a difference will be held in Cogan's Bar on Friday, November 16 at 9.00pm. THE OLD KILFARBOY SOCIETY TALK – The Malbay, Miltown Malbay Tuesday 13 November at 8 p.m. Admission €5. Membership €20. This covers admission to all 6 talks.OAP: €10. All are welcome.This talk will explore the valuable, yet largely unknown, contribution made by the Queen's Nursing Institute (or Jubilee) and Lady Dudley Scheme nurses towards the health of peripheral areas of the west of Ireland. The Jubilee nurses supplemented the nursing service provided by the Dispensary District, yet these women lived and worked in relative isolation for meagre lodgings and pay. This talk will discuss how did these programmes become established and chronicle the important contribution towards the development of community healthcare.
